From the Homestead of the Old Vine Barossa Shiraz!

Hello my One Lonely Barrel Friends, I mentioned in our last newsletter (April Issue) that this is my last Semester to complete my Post Graduate Diploma in Oenology and Viticulture through the University of Adelaide.

Here I am, still at it, with only 4 weeks of study left! I have 3 more assignments to do and then the EXAMS! Nothing has changed in 50 years since my year 12 exams. I am still anxious along with my class mates. The secondary subject in the course is cellar and winery waste management and looking at best practices to protect the environment, climate change and sustainability.

Just a note on the general wine market, no doubt there is a lot of wine on the market at extremely low prices. In my view you need to be cautious. If you know the wine then buy it and enjoy it. If you don't know the wine it may not end up being a bargain, if you do not like it. Unlike large wineries we do not have huge stock levels. Once the vintage of around 200-240 cases have sold there is no more. In this very competitive market, you can be confident, that **One Lonely Barrel can be trusted for Quality Wines at Exceptional Value.** All our wines are getting down to low stock levels, including the 2018 Old Vine Barossa Shiraz, 2020 Basket Press Shiraz and the Chosen One Range. New vintages are due in July/August. I recommend you get in early to buy your favorite wines before they sell out.

Update on the Mataro.....

The Mataro is quietly and gently maturing in Oak, after this semester we will look at bottling. Not sure if we will bottle as a Mataro or go for a GSM(Grenache/Shiraz/Mataro). We are asking for your view and feedback, what would you like to drink?

2022 Vintage - The Crescent Basket Press Shiraz- -Picked on the 26th of March this year. Is ready for its first racking off the lees. Some acid adjustments, a dose of PMS to prevent oxidation and put to bed over the winter months. Late August early September we wake it up and do a post winter racking.

The 2020 Basket Press is down to our last pallet, and drinking well. Where can you buy a Basket Press Shiraz for under \$20 a bottle? This wine is also a medal winning wine. If you have not tried it yet, be quick as we are keen to soon launch our 2021 Vintage! You can also try it in our Tasting 6 pack for \$99. (see below for details)

Our 2018 Old Vine Barossa Shiraz is down to the last couple of pallets. If you have not tried it, all I can say is it will surprise and not disappoint. Wines of this quality are in the \$80 plus range but our Old Vine is under \$30 a bottle when you buy it by the 6 pack or by the dozen. Exceptional!

I am taking a look at our 2020 and 2021 Old Vine Barossa Shiraz next week, so I will do an update next month.

You might be aware that we are in a number of Restaurants in Adelaide with our Range of wines. Plus, we are also in a few retail outlets. Make sure that if you are dining in one of the Restaurants below that you ask for our wines and if you need to pick up a bottle of Old Vine Barossa Shiraz, you can find it at the East End Cellars or Sip n Save Torrens Arm Mitcham.
